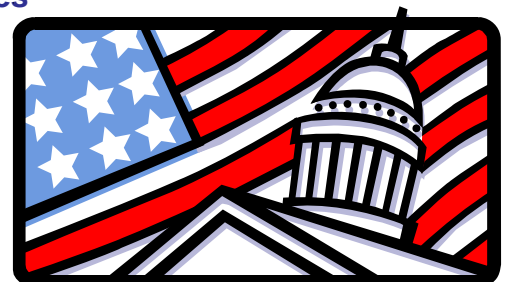
CTE Needs You! Step Up, Speak Out, and Stand With Us! Register Today!

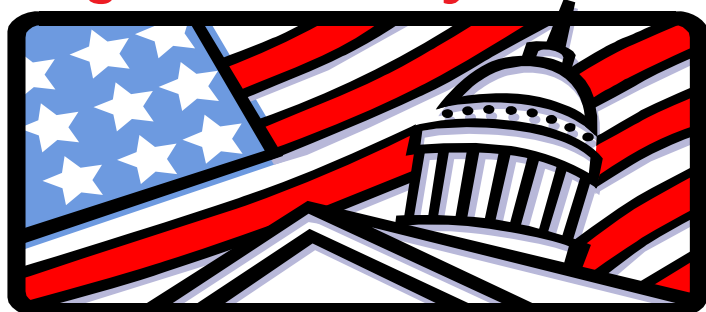
