- Some presentations descriptions mentioned specific tools or take-aways and instead just shared theory. Tangible products to use in the classroom are always more appealing than theory.
- Would like all admin strand in same area. Had to walk a lot. Have "no show" check-in...if presenter didn't show, have a way to tell someone...maybe on app?
