- 1. **SkillsUSA Washington** received membership growth awards in all three divisions (Middle School, High School, and College/Post-Secondary) receiving the largest growth in the nation in the College/Post-Secondary division
- 2. SkillsUSA Washington brought 124 contestants to NLSC
 - 11 Medalists
 - 1 Gold
 - 8 Silver
 - 2 Bronze
 - 48 students in the top 10
 - 52 certificates earned on site deeming the student "industry ready" in their career field of study
