Issues

- 1. Perkins V continues to add accountability via increased data gathering and entry by districts, and the supports from OSPI are very general, which is a concern, until the CPR process for Perkins V teaches us the true target (we all had experience of Perkins IV and many CPR cycles to learn best practice). The response to the new accountability falls to districts and their data vendors to solve, which does not seem to be best practice from the monitoring agency.
- 2. The good push for Career Launch initiatives is positive, however, the initial funding goes to the intermediary/planning group, and not to the district or post-secondary institution. Once the CL program begins, post-secondary has increased FTE and K-12 has some access to extra WSL FTE, but there are several misconceptions on how useful this extra WSL FTE is to districts.
