The Workforce Board is co-hosting the Governor's Summit on Career Connected Learning on May 31. The Governor will speak at the Microsoft campus, along with industry, policy, and education leaders who will discuss how to create more career-related opportunities to prepare Washington youth for high-demand jobs. The Summit is the culmination of an 18-month Policy Academy on Work-Based Learning led by the Workforce Board and the Governor's Office.
