This week's update:

This week Legislators begin the work of hearing and moving (or not) bills passed over to them from the opposite chamber. Below you will find bills related to our CTE focus areas, with several scheduled for hearings the week of March 18. You will find committee, day, and time information in the list of bills at the end of this update.

Key bills that connect to the three focus areas of our [WA-ACTE Legislative Strategic Plan](#):

- **FOCUS: CTE RESOURCES (Funding):**
 - *We continue to work on in the House and Senate to try and make something happen if we can; having failed on our first attempt to find a vehicle to amend with our CTE Resources language we continue to work on that method as well as lay the groundwork to possibly include something in the final budget bill. - **FOCUS: THE VALUE OF CTE:**
 - [E2SHB 1599](#) - Provides multiple pathway approach to high school graduation that require students to **complete a High School and Beyond Plan, earn required credits towards graduation, and successfully complete one or more pathways** in order to earn a high school diploma. (Senate Hearing Rm 1, 03/20/2019@1:30 pm)
 - These pathways include:
 - Earning high school credit in a high school transition course, an English and language arts or mathematics dual credit course, a CTE sequence of courses or program of study, or through an apprenticeship preparation program
 - Meeting or exceeding scores in high school assessments, SAT/ACT, or certain dual credit exams
 - Passing the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery
 - Passing an industry-based exam
 - [E2SSB 5327](#) - Creates a multi-agency work group to coordinate Career Connected Learning (CCL) opportunities, collect data, provide recommendations, and perform other duties. Creates a competitive grant program to support regional networks and program intermediaries in expanding CCL opportunities. Requires school districts to be funded up to 1.2 full-time equivalents for students in certain CCL programs, subject to amounts appropriated. Requires the institutions of higher education to have CCL coordinators to engage faculty and institutional leadership in expanding the number of certain CCL programs, subject to amounts appropriated. - **FOCUS: SUPPORT CTE STUDENT LEADERSHIP:**

Hopefully you are engaged in actions to support our CTE advocacy efforts, so here are some actions you may consider taking. ***Always remember to advocate on your own time and only using your personal email. Never use work resources to be assured that you do not violate PDC laws as a public employee.***

- Review the week ahead committee meeting schedule, focusing on bills still alive in the process that have been scheduled for public hearing, then contact your legislators asking them to support our two CTE bills – especially if they serve on one of the committees where the bill has been assigned.
- Reach out with your perspective on the bill and share your story, consider coming to Olympia to meet with your member, and testify on a bill important to you.
- Share CTE program data from your school/district, stories, and suggestions to improve the proposed policy from your prospective is important to legislators. *You are the expert for your program and the needs of your students so don't be anxious to share your story.*
- Follow-up with legislators/committees on a specific bill or issue.
- Provide input on bills not yet scheduled for hearings that are an issue or area of interest or concern to you.
