## **Washington ACTE - 2023 Policy Priorities**

WA-ACTE Legislative Vision – To maximize the ability for CTE to support the future of work and our state's economy by providing access to quality CTE programs while building out the current CTE Graduation Pathway.

<u>Class Size Funding</u> – Work within proposed legislation to change the class sizeteacher ratio back to 19 students from 23 students (current) and from 20 (current) to 16 for Skill Centers.

<u>Capital Equipment Grants</u> – Secure capital budget grant funding (\$25 million) for new and restarting CTE programs for individual schools.

<u>CTSO Participation Funding</u> – Work to secure funding for student participation in their Career and Technical Student Organization.

<u>Principal Certification</u> – Advocate for CTE information provided within administrator and/or principal certification programs statewide.
