## **Welcome to the Monday WOVE!**

Reminder – the WOVE will be sent on Monday's for the remainder of the legislative session. Last week necessitated the need to shift delivery to Monday's and this will provide opportunity to have late developments in the week and last minute changes for what bills will be heard the following week.

Case in point, at 4:54 PM on Saturday an evening notice was sent that [SB 5853](#), a CTE funding bill, was scheduled for a hearing on Monday at 1:30 PM. Having a Monday WOVE at least gave us a chance to get the word out in the newsletter.

## **Federal Level Activities:** (Perkins)

The ACTE National Policy Seminar happened last week in Washington D.C. While there continues to be support for Career and Technical Education (CTE) at the national level there is great uncertainty how it will fair in the final federal budget. On Thursday the President released his "skinny budget" (just the highlights) with his funding proposals. You have no doubt been hearing in the news about his proposed cuts, including a 13.5% reduction to the Department of Education. Perkins at this point remains un-named in his list of programs to cut...stay tuned.

## **Career and Technical Education (CTE) this coming week in Olympia:**

The Senate is expected to release its budget on Tuesday, March 21 and the House the following week. Good news is the latest state revenue forecast has increased revenue for the state to work with, but in no way will cover the full cost estimated to meet the state's McCleary obligation.

Monday (3/20) will be an action packed day for CTE in two different committees, first...

## **Support for CTE in Policy Bills:**

### **Monday March 20**

**1:30 pm in Senate Early Learning & K-12 Education;**

**[SHB 1046](#) - Concerning certificates of academic and individual achievement (MacEwen)**

Passed overwhelmingly with bi-partisan support off the House floor.

**Opposed:** State Board of Education, Business Roundtable

**Pro:** OSPI, WA Education Association, Washington ACTE, WA School Board Directors

**Effect of bill:** De-links the standardized tests federally required to be administered in high school from graduation requirements in WA (one 2<sup>nd</sup> year Algebra math test in 11<sup>th</sup> grade, one Biology science test, one English Language Arts test in 10<sup>th</sup> grade).

## **CTE Resources & K-12 Funding:**

**3:30 pm in Senate Ways & Means;**

**[SB 5853](#) - Concerning Career and Technical Education funding (Walsh)**

This bill underscores the importance of increasing CTE funding, but does not specify the mechanism (MSOC prototype multiplier or student weighted formula). [SB 5853](#) also includes the "Allowable Expenditures" list, which limits how funds can be spent- directing more dollars to programs. This language has been perfected with the input of partners to highlight mentorships, community and industry partnerships, and collaboration between K-12 and the Community & Technical Colleges. This is *as important* as the funding.

Our definition for CTE funding success in whatever funding formula ultimately passes this year will need to have these key points:

- Are there additional operating resources for CTE & SC program delivery going forward
- Are there assurances that those resources are directed to CTE programs thus relieving CTE building budgets of the burden of base salaries negotiated beyond the state allocation
